Note 1. ****IMPORTANT**** - Pilots wishing to save a FPL for future use are requested to leave the DOF/EOBT field blank. DOF/EOBT should only be completed at time of submission.

Note 2. FPLs are being submitted with incorrect DOF due to the change in the UTC day. The DOF for flights with an EOBT prior to 0000UTC for current local day should be entered as the local day before.

Note 3. Successful submission of all FPL will be confirmed by the receipt of a NAIPS acceptance message. Pilots should check this message for accuracy and retain or print a copy.

Note 4. Pictorial representation of Australian SIGMET are now available. AVFAX Product or Chart Codes 81210, 81211 and 81212 refer.

VNC Chart example

The Amberley Restricted Airspace is depicted by red lines and smaller red font. Don't get confused by the normal CTA airspace lines of blue with bigger blue font depicting the airspace steps.

In the example circled below, if BIG AMB is active the Lower Level (LL) of R625C is 4500 however the blue/brown font reads E LL 8500, C LL FL125.



If Amberley is active, then the red lines apply. This is where pre-flight planning is critical, so ensure you carefully study the charts.
