Private Pilot Licence (PPL)

The PPL training course is centered around the theory and practice of navigation, navigation aids, and controlled airspace operations. PPL holders can fly anywhere within Australia, including through controlled airspace and into controlled airports. The PPL is a gateway and pre-requisite to advanced training options such as night flying and instrument flying ratings.

FULL TIME:	4 weeks, weather permitting
PART TIME:	As required (progress at your own pace)
PRE-REQUISITES:	Recreational Pilot Licence or RA-AUS pilot certificate
PRIVILEGES:	Any privilege from the RPL Act as pilot in command of a single engine aeroplane Carry passengers on private flights Operate within Australia, inside or outside of controlled airspace or aerodromes Operate airborne radio equipment in an aviation environment, including in CTA Certify an aeroplane is serviceable for flight
MILESTONES:	First cross country navigation solo, first cross country controlled airspace solo
