<b>PRIVILEGES:</b>	Act as pilot in command of an aeroplane with an all up weight not exceeding 1500kg Carry passengers on private flights Operate within 25 nautical miles of the departure aerodrome, outside of controlled airspace Operate airborne radio equipment in an aviation environment Certify an aeroplane is serviceable for flight
