CASA Medical examination fees. Your selected DAME will be able to advise their current costs. In addition, CASA charges a \$75 assessment fee for reviewing the medical.

ASIC Card: As of February 2023, the cost of an ASIC card is \$264

Flight Examiner Test Fees: As of February 2023 the test fee for PPL, CPL, IR and MECLR is \$900 per test -payable to the examiner.
