Commercial Pilot Licence (CPL)

The PPL holder will already possess the skills and knowledge to safely operate an aircraft in a private setting, so the CPL course focus is on development of existing skills to satisfy the requirements of operations in the commercial environment. CPL training hones handling skills, improves knowledge, introduces more complex aircraft, and simulates commercial pressures such as working within time constraints and operating in more challenging weather conditions.

FULL TIME:	3 months, weather permitting
PART TIME:	As required (progress at your own pace)
PRE-REQUISITES:	Private Pilot Licence
PRIVILEGES:	Any privilege from the RPL or PPL Act as pilot in command of an aircraft during commercial operations Act as co-pilot of a multi-crew aircraft during commercial operations
MILESTONES:	Command hour building completion, general handling phase completion
